How to Use the Cal Long Term Care Compare Website

Follow the instructions below to search for long-term care facilities where you live. This includes nursing homes, hospice care, home health care, assisted living facilities, adult residential facilities, continuing care retirement communities, and adult day health centers.

- 1. Go to www.CalLongTermCareCompare.org
- 2. Click on "Select Type of Care" and use the dropdown menu to make your choice.
- 3. Type your zip code, city, or name of facility into the box to the right of the type of care you chose.
- Your results will appear on the left-hand side of your screen. Click on the facility's name to learn more about it.

Follow these instructions to compare multiple facilities.

- 1. Follow steps 1-3 above.
- 2. Click on "Save and Compare" for up to six facilities.
- 3. Click on "My Saved Providers" toward the top righthand side of your screen.
- Choose to compare providers or have your list emailed to you. When you compare providers, you can save your choices as a PDF, print the page, or share your choices by email.
